- **Tell the truth.** Iona Senior Services does not permit comments that are libelous. In other words, don't make untrue statements about people or organizations. Additionally, spreading unsupported accusations or false information is prohibited.
- **No promotional comments.** We will not post comments that are spam or that solely promote services or products.

All of our comments are moderated to ensure that they meet the above standards. We will review and post them as promptly as possible during regular business hours (Monday through Friday, 9:00 am - 5:00 pm). We reserve the right to make editorial decisions regarding submitted comments, including but not limited to removal of comments.

Iona Senior Services also requires that you register and post your comment with your actual name and e-mail address, in order to promote visibility and open dialogue.
