SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. Up to 10 images (saved as .jpg) to be sent as attachments to email, together with [Entry Application](#) and 1-2 page CV.
2. Each image size should be less than 2MB, with longest side at less than 1600 pixels, and resolution set at 72 dpi.
3. Identify each image file. Numbering must correspond with list on Entry Application. Example: #_ImageTitle_Lastname_Firstname_.jpg
4. All artwork must be the artist's original creation within the last 10 years and must be available at time of exhibition.
5. Artwork should not exceed 50-inches in width, including frame, and weigh less than 30-lbs.
6. Artwork must be framed, labeled on the back with artist's name, title, & number to correspond with list on Entry Application, and ready to hang when delivered.
7. Artist or designated agent must deliver and retrieve works to/from gallery only during designated dates and times. Gallery will not accept crated or packaged artwork.
